

RESOLUTION NO. 39-1991

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH CLACKAMAS COUNTY WHICH PROVIDES THE BASIS FOR A COOPERATIVE WORKING RELATIONSHIP FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTATING SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS USING AVAILABLE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie is desirous of making grants available to low income property owners for the repair of sidewalks in City rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie has applied for and has been awarded CDBG funds to intitiate sidewalk repairs for low income property owners; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie has budgeted matching funds for the portion of repairs anticipated to be completed during this fiscal year; and


WHEREAS, the County is charged with administering the CDBG program within Clackamas County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie has completed a right-of-way inventory which has identified sidewalks within the City which are in need of repair, therefore


BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie that it hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign an intergovernmental cooperative agreement with Clackamas County which provides the basis for a cooperative working relationship for purpose of implementating a sidewalk improvement program using CDBG funding to provide assistance to low income property owners.


