RESOLUTION NO. 6-1991

A RESOLUTION OF THE MILWAUKIE CITY COUNCIL CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION TO SUBMIT TO THE REGISTERED, QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY THE QUESTION OF CONTRACTING A GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDED INDEBTEDNESS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000) TO FINANCE, IN PART, THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITY AND TO PAY FOR ALL COSTS INCIDENTAL THERETO.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the present public safety facilities are inadequate to serve the public's needs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has evaluated a number of options for improvement of the City's public safety facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the option most beneficial to the public is the construction of a new public safety facility which would house emergency dispatch, the police department, fire administration and which would replace the current fire station located at SE 40th and Harvey Streets; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of such a public safety facility project is estimated to be between \$4.7 and \$5.6 million dollars; and

WHEREAS, the City has set aside \$561,000 within the 1990-91 budget for the public safety facility project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council proposes to finance the remaining cost of the public safety facility project by the contracting of a general obligation bonded indebtedness in an amount not to exceed five million dollars (\$5,000,000); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 287.004, the City may issue bonds upon approval of a majority of the electors of the city voting upon the question of issuance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Milwaukie City Council that:

Section 1. An election is hereby called in and for the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon on Tuesday, May 21, 1990, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City the question of contracting a general obligation bonded indebtedness in the name of the City in an amount not to exceed five million dollars (\$5,000,000).

Section 2. The following ballot is hereby approved and shall be printed on the official ballot as set forth below:

CITY OF MILWAUKIE  
GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND AUTHORIZATION

Question: Shall the City issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000 to build a public safety facility?

Explanation: This measure, if approved, allows the City to contract general obligation bonded indebtedness to build a public safety facility. It also allows refunding of these bonds, if needed. The bonds would mature over 20 years or less. Sale of the bonds would be used to pay for building the facility and all incidental costs. Present buildings would be put to other uses or sold. The new building would house emergency dispatch, the police department, fire administration and a fire station.

Section 3. The election shall be conducted by the Clackamas County Elections Department, which department shall establish polling places, precincts, and election boards for such election. The election may be conducted by mail pursuant to ORS 254.465 et seq.

Section 4. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to certify in the manner provided for by law to the Elections Director of Clackamas County, Oregon, the foregoing measure for inclusion as a part of the regular ballots to be prepared by the Elections Director for voting at all precincts within the City of Milwaukie at the special election on May 21, 1991.

Section 5. The City Recorder shall be, and is hereby further authorized and directed to give notice of receipt of the ballot title as required by ORS 250.275, by publishing in the Daily Courier on March 22, 1991.

Section 6. The City Recorder of the City of Milwaukie is hereby ordered and directed to post notice of said election in a conspicuous place in City Hall. This notice shall be posted at least ten (10) days before the date set for the election. The City Recorder shall give additional notice of the aforesaid City election by publication at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, the first publication to be not less than ten (10) days before the election. The notice shall contain the ballot title under which the question will appear on the ballot and shall set forth the time and place of said election.
