RESOLUTION 21-1988

WHEREAS, the Milwaukie City Council finds that the reconstruction of an historic mill, Moore's Flour Mill, would foster the economic growth and legislative policy as set forth in ORS 280.520 and 280.585, and

WHEREAS, ORS 280.532 requires, before the approval of an Oregon Business Development Fund project by the State of Oregon, that the governing body of the appropriate local government recommend the project, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the completion of the flour mill within the City of Milwaukie would be in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Milwaukie, and would help to preserve the heritage of the community,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

That the City of Milwaukie requests the Economic Development Commission and the State of Oregon to assist in the financing of Moore's Flour Mill project within the City of Milwaukie, through the Oregon Business Development Fund, secured by the improvements as provided by ORS 280.532.
