RESOLUTION NO. 23-1988

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ESTABLISHING AN URBAN SERVICE GROWTH BOUNDARY AND A DUAL INTEREST AREA IN AREAS SOUTH OF THE CITY AND ADJACENT TO THE OAK LODGE SERVICE DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie and the Oak Lodge Service Districts (Sanitary Sewer, Water, and Fire) desire to establish responsibility for urban services provision within a boundary; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie provides water and sewer service to unincorporated properties outside its south western boundary; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie and the service districts recognize the need to provide a full range of efficient, cost effective urban services now and in the future; and

WHEREAS, the City has an dual interest in an area adjacent to its boundary wherein land use and development may impact the City at its border; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a city growth boundary will enhance long range planning and urban service provision stability.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie that:

- 1. An urban services growth boundary be approved as described in Exhibit A (attached); and
- 2. A dual interest area be designated beyond the growth boundary as described in Exhibit A (attached).
