RESOLUTION NO. 24-1988

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT AND HILLMAN POWELL REGARDING IMPROVEMENTS AT THE INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAY 224 AND OAK STREET.

WHEREAS, the request of Hillman Powell, Developer, for approval of commercial improvements at the intersection of Highway 224 and Oak Street impacts traffic and will necessitate a traffic signal and improved illumination, and

WHEREAS, the agreement states that the State Highway Department will provide Hillman Powell with specifications, design, and a list of state-approved contractors; will administer the actual construction; and will maintain the traffic signal, and

WHEREAS, Hillman Powell will select a contractor and will pay 100% of the costs associated with the design and construction of these improvements, and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie agreed in June, 1967 to pay lighting costs associated with traffic signals and illumination, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie that it hereby authorizes the City Manager to sign a three-party agreement with the State Highway Department, Hillman Powell, and the City of Milwaukie regarding improvement to the intersection of Highway 224 and Oak Street.
