

RESOLUTION NO. 4-1989

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE ESTABLISHING A
POLICY REGARDING APPOINTMENTS TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.**

WHEREAS, Milwaukie Municipal Code, Section 2.04.410, Paragraph A provides that commissions "should be balanced, insofar as possible, between the different economic, social, geographic, racial, sex and age groups in the community." and,

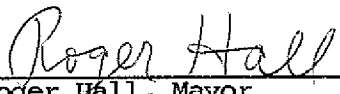
WHEREAS, Milwaukie Municipal Code, Section 2.04.410, Paragraph C provides that commissions "should contain a variety of philosophies among the different members." and,

WHEREAS, the Council is desirous of establishing a policy which helps ensure that these standards are met and,

WHEREAS, appointment of members from the same household to the same commission would not ensure that these standards are met, now therefore,

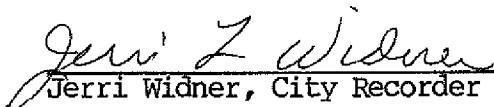
BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie that it is the policy of the Council not to appoint members of the same household (as defined in ORS 244.020[10]) to the same commission. Nothing in this policy prohibits family members from being appointed to different boards or commissions.
