

RESOLUTION NO. 9-1987

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF RIGOROUS DRUNK DRIVING LAWS FOR ALL MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVERS.

WHEREAS, Motor vehicle trauma is two to three times greater than any other cause of fatalities due to injury, and

WHEREAS, Various studies indicate that 50-90% of drivers involved in vehicle accidents had alcohol present in their systems, and

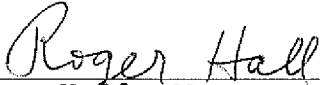
WHEREAS, Drunk drivers kill other, innocent people more often than they kill themselves, and

WHEREAS, For every death, there are five to ten persons maimed with permanent disabling injuries, and approximately 100 less serious injuries,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, supports passage and enforcement of rigorous drunk driving laws for all motor vehicle drivers, and

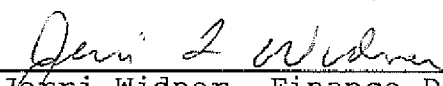
Supports the educational efforts regarding the drunk driving epidemic and efforts to control the problem.

Introduced and adopted by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie on February 17th, 1987.



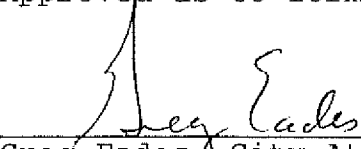
