

RESOLUTION NUMBER 26 -1982

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE REPEALING RESOLUTION 28-1971 AND CHANGING PORTIONS OF S.E. MAIN STREET, S.E. MONROE STREET AND S.E. JEFFERSON STREET FROM ONE-WAY TO TWO-WAY.

WHEREAS, it has been proposed by the Milwaukie USA Business Association of the City of Milwaukie that certain streets in the business district of the city be designated as two-way streets to allow better movement of vehicular traffic, and

The proposal has been reviewed by the department officials for the city, and

The proposal has been presented at a meeting of businessmen in the area to be regulated and has been generally approved by those present, and

The Council for the City of Milwaukie has determined that it would create more favorable traffic conditions within the downtown area to designate certain streets in the business district of the city as streets to be used by vehicular traffic traveling in a two-way direction,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie:


1. Resolution 28-1971 is repealed in its entirety.
2. That S.E. Main Street south of its intersection with S.E. Jackson Street to the intersection of S.E. Adams Street be designated as a thoroughfare on which vehicular traffic shall travel in a southerly and northerly direction.
3. That S.E. Main Street south of the intersection of S.E. Adams Street to the intersection of S.E. Lake Road be designated as a street on which vehicular traffic shall travel only in a southerly direction.
4. That S.E. Lake Road from its intersection with S.E. Main Street to its intersection with S.E. 21st Street be designated as a street on which vehicular traffic shall travel only in a southeasterly direction.
5. That S.E. Monroe Street east of its intersection with S.E. McLoughlin Boulevard and west of its intersection with S.E. 21st Street be designated as a street on which vehicular traffic shall travel in an easterly and westerly direction.

6. That S.E. Jefferson Street east of its intersection with S.E. McLoughlin Boulevard and west of its intersection with S.E. 21st Street be designated as a street on which vehicular traffic shall travel in an easterly and westerly direction.

7. That these changes be completed not later than October 1982, weather permitting.

Be it so resolved.
