

RESOLUTION NUMBER 34-1981


A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE PROVIDING MEDICAL INSURANCE BENEFITS FOR RETIRED CITY EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the Council desires to extend medical insurance coverage to certain retired city employees, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie that management and confidential employees who retire after 10 years or more service with the city shall be provided continued employee and (if applicable) dependent coverage under the city medical insurance plan at the city's cost.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this benefit will only apply to those persons insured as of the date of retirement and shall continue for five years from the date of retirement or until the retiree is eligible for Medicaid coverage, whichever occurs first. Employees who retire at the applicable mandatory retirement age shall be continued until they are eligible for Medicaid coverage.


