RESOLUTION NUMBER 21-1980

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON CANVASSING THE VOTE AT A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 25, 1980.

WHEREAS, on March 25, 1980, a special election was held in the City of Milwaukie, conducted and supervised by the Clackamas County Clerk, and

WHEREAS, the Clackamas County Clerk has certified to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, the vote of the people at said city election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the City of Milwaukie, by and through its Council, does hereby canvass the vote and accepts and approves the following count as certified by the Clackamas County Clerk, on the following proposition:

PROPOSITION 51. REVENUE BOND ISSUE FOR PROPERTY ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENT.

QUESTION: "Shall the City of Milwaukie issue \$375,000 in revenue bonds to purchase and develop property at 10964 S.E. Oak Street?"

"Purpose: If approved, no additional property taxes will be levied and the bonds would be paid entirely from water and sewer fund revenues and state gas tax funds. The present Public Works Shop facilities are in a residential area and are inadequate for the needs of the city. The property to be is centrally located, adjacent to existing city-owned property, and already has a building which could be used immediately with some improvements."
