RESOLUTION NO. 1-1980

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN ELECTRICAL ENERGY SUPPLY EMERGENCY IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE AND INSTITUTING VOLUNTARY ENERGY CONSERVATION MEASURES.

WHEREAS, there is now existent in the tri-county area, including the City of Milwaukie, a potential short fall of available electrical energy to meet current residential, commercial, industrial, and public energy demands, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie in recognition of this situation believes that the imposition of voluntary energy conservation measures is necessary to prevent disruption of electrical energy supply to citizens of the City of Milwaukie, now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE That an electrical energy supply emergency is hereby declared for the City of Milwaukie and the following voluntary measures to conserve electrical energy within the City of Milwaukie are strongly encouraged:

- 1. Non-essential illumination sources in commercial establishments should not be activated. To this end, lighting for outdoor illumination and parking should be kept at a level commensurate to afford reasonable public safety.
- 2. Occupants in residences should exercise restraint in exterior illumination and should participate in electrical conservation measures such as: (1) lowering of thermostat levels (2) installation of insulation and storm windows,

- (3) lowering electrical water heater temperatures, (4) consolidation of washer and dryer loads, (5) turning off unnecessary interior lighting
 - 3. Expiration date six months from date of adoption BE IT SO RESOLVED.
