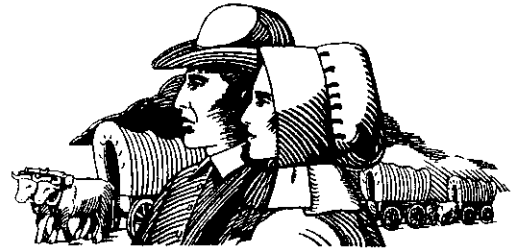

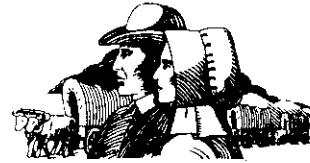

Staff requests that the Planning Commission continue the hearing for the above referenced file to July 12, 2004. 
