CITY OF OREGON CITY PLANNING COMMISSION MINUTES June 25, 2001

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Carter called the meeting to order.

2. PUBLIC COMMENT ON ITEMS NOT LISTED ON AGENDA

None.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: June 11, 2001

Chairperson Carter asked if the reference, on page two, to Mr. Rich is correct. **Mr. Kabeiseman** stated that the reference should be to Mr. George. Commissioner Surratt moved to accept the minutes of the June 11, 2001 Planning Commission meeting with noted change, **Commissioner Mengelberg** seconded.

While waiting for representatives of the Oregon City School District to arrive, the Planning Commission conducted portions of the New Business agenda.

4. NEW BUSINESS

A. Draft Letter to Endorse and Support Grant Application

Maggie Collins explained that the purpose of the grant applied for is to obtain funds to complete the Downtown Community Plan Phase II work. She explained that the Staff had drafted a letter of support for the grant application, and requested the Commission approve the letter by motion.

Chairperson Carter noted several errors needing correction:

- 1. The letter's salutation reads 'Mr. Gardiner', and it should read 'Ms. (Gloria) Gardiner'.
- 2. In the second paragraph, third line, the phrase 'Comprehensive Plan' is repeated.
- 3. In the last bullet item, line two, the phrase 'greaterpublic safety' should be 'greater public safety'.

Mr. Kabeiseman suggested that, in the first paragraph, the second line, the word 'Assistant' should be 'Assistance'.

Commissioner Bailey moved to approve the draft letter in support of the grant application, with noted corrections. **Commissioner Mengelberg** seconded.

5. PUBLIC HEARINGS

Chairperson Carter reviewed the public hearing process and stated the time limitations for the speakers in the public hearing. **Chairperson Carter** asked if any Commissioner had visited the sites or had a conflict of interest.

All Commissioners stated that they had no ex parte conflicts with this matter.

STAFF REPORT

Maggie Collins reviewed the Staff report. Commissioner Bailey asked Ms. Collins to confirm that the request is to approve changing the site's zoning from a County designation to a City designation, and that the site was annexed by the City previously but the zoning was not changed at that time. He asked if the Commission or the Staff will have to approve a conditional use permit in the future. Ms. Collins said the Staff can approve the conditional use permit, and that any action on the property will be part of the site plan for the entire site. She emphasized that any change or difference to the approved site plan in the future would require a conditional use permit review. Commission would have to approve a follow on conditional use permit. Ms. Collins said the Commission would have to approve a follow on conditional use permit. Ms. Collins said the Commission would see another conditional use permit request only if there is a deviation from the site plan the Staff is currently working. She clarified that the School District has a conditional use permit for each parcel of the proposed new high school campus.

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Chairperson Carter asked why the zoning change request was not for an R-8 designation as opposed to the campus industrial designation. **Ms. Collins** explained that the property was annexed into the City as industrial. She said the automatic R-10 that gets assigned to residential property annexed to the City cannot be assigned to industrial property. She explained that the City's industrial planned map designation has three zones: CI campus industrial, M-1 light industry, and M-2 heavy industry. She said there is no automatic assignment of an industrial zone to property that comes into the City designated as industrial on the Plan map. **Commissioner Bailey** pointed out that to have an R-8 designation, the request would have required a change to the City's Comprehensive Plan. **Ms. Collins** agreed. **Chairperson Carter** asked for confirmation that the zone change to an annexed property has to be done after the City has completed the annexation process. **Ms. Collins** said that was correct.

She said that the total number of dwelling units possible is eight.

Chairperson Carter asked if there had been any comment from the neighbors or the neighborhood association. **Ms. Collins** said that the Staff had received no comments.

Commissioner Bailey suggested that the Staff re-word Basic Facts # 3 to something like: "The subject property currently consists of two parcels. If the Planning Commission approves this rezone to RD-4, under the Code requirements, the subject property may be ultimately divided into 4 duplex lots, with a total density of 8 housing units.

Commissioner Bailey moved, based upon the findings of fact, as corrected, to recommend the City Commission approve **ZC 01-03**; Thomas Hurt; Zone Change from R-10 (Single-Family Dwelling District) to RD-4 (Two-Family Dwelling District); 678/674 & 668 Warner Parrott Raod/ Map # 3-2E-6DB, Tax Lot 1700 & 1800, and adopt proposed Ordinance 01-1024. **Commissioner Mengelberg** seconded.

Chairperson Carter reported that she, Mayor Williams, and City Commissioner Nealy attended the public hearing for the Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program and testified in support of the Oregon City projects.

Commissioner Mengelberg distributed to Commissioners copies of a brochure advertising a workshop on sustainability. The workshop, called the Oregon Sustainability Forum, scheduled for September 4-6, 2001, in Portland. **Commissioner Surratt** asked if the City would be willing to sponsor Commissioners to attend. **Ms. Collins** said she would review the budget after July 1, 2001, and that money for partial sponsorship might be available.
