SPECIAL MEETING

The City Commission met in special session on the above date in the office of the City Manager at 1:00 o'clock p.m.

Roll call showed the following present:

George Woodward and Raymond Caufield, Commissioners
J.L. Franzen, City Manager

Ordinance No. 1328, an ordinance amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1294, an ordinance creating and establishing Fire Zones within the limits of Oregon City, was read the second time and on motion placed on its final passage, and it appearing from the certificate of June Lambert, principal clerk of the Publisher of the Oregon City Enterprise, that the same had been properly published as required by the Charter, the ordinance was passed.

Ordinance No. 1329, an ordinance vacating a portion of McLoughlin Promenade, a public street in Oregon City, Oregon, located in the Oregon City claim in Sec. 31, Township 2 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian in Oregon City, was read the second time and on motion placed on its final passage, and it appearing from the certificate of June Lambert, principal clerk of the Publisher of the Oregon City Enterprise, that the same had been properly published as required by the Charter, the ordinance was passed.

The following resolution, entering into a contract with J.C. Stevens and R.E. Koon for consulting service on sewage disposal plant, was read and adopted.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Stevens and Coon, a co-partnership composed of J.C. Stevens and R.E. Koon, both of Portland, Oregon, have submitted to Oregon City a proposed contract for engineering services for the sewage collection and treatment in Oregon City, Oregon, the original of which is on file in the City Recorder's office and provides generally for the furnishing of general engineering services for the planning, surveying, specifications, as set forth in said contract, at a total cost of \$9,500.00, and

Whereas, it is to the best interests of Oregon City that said contract be executed,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Recorder for and on behalf of Oregon City be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into said above described contract.
