intersection of the center line of John Adams Street with the center line of Second Street in Oregon City, according to the duly recorded plat thereof; thence from said begining point run N. 87° 50' W. 90.90 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 32° 48' W. 100.00 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 71° 16' W. 100.00 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 3° 03' E. 84.30 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 84° 10' W. 194.30 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 6° 39' E. 137.50 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 6° 39' E. 137.50 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 88° 51' E. 100.40 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 29° 26' E. 100.00 feet to an iron piep; thence N. 4° 05(W. 200.00 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 31° 06' E. 177.30 feet to the place of beginning, save and except public roads as shown on the attached map. (on said deed)

conditioned only that said property shall be used only for State or Federal military purposes and, if at any time after one year from the date hereof, said property ceases to be used for State or Federal military purposes for a period of five years said property shall revert to the City of Oregon City and the State of Oregon shall have an additional one year from the termination of such abandonment within which to remove the buildins and if said buildings are not so removed within said time they shall revert to and become the property of Oregon City.

AND Inasmuch as this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of Oregon City in this: In order for the local unit of the Oregon National Guard to be entitled to receive the funds appropriated by the United States Government to construct said building, the title to the property upon which the buildings are to be erected must be in the State of Oregon and as said funds are made available at the present time and must be applied for immediately, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval and passage by the City Commission.
