The regular meeting of the City Commission was held on the above date in the Commission Chambers at City Hall at 8:00 P.M.

It was moved by Faust, seconded by Bowman, that the following resolution changing the ballot title as requested by the League for Better Government be passed.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, initiative petitions have been filed with the City Recorder on March 2, 9, and 25, and April 19, 1960, respectfully demanding that charter amendments contained in said initiative petitions be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Oregon City for their approval or rejection at a city election to be held on May 20, 1960, and

WHEREAS, on April 27, 1960, the City Recorder requested the City Attorney to prepare a ballot title for said charter amendments contained in said initiative petitions, and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney on May 2, 1960, pursuant to the Charter of Oregon City, has provided, returned and filed with the City Recorder ballot title for said measure as follows:

For the system of civil service:

Charter amendments amending Section 8 of Chapter II and Section 43 of Chapter VII of the Charter and also amending Section 57 of Chapter VIII of the Charter by adding a new section being section 57B, which removes the power of the City Manager to discharge any employee with or without cause and provides for a system of civil service for employees in all full time positions, except elected officials, Manager, Recorder, Attorney and Health Officer, said civil Service system to be substantially the same in application for all included employees, positions and places.

For union membership and collective bargaining:

Charter amendment amending Section 57 of Chapter VIII of the Charter by adding a new section being Section 57C providing that city employees are guaranteed the privilege of joining a union of their choice with no discrimination by city officials for joining a union nor right of any person to exercise any restraint, interference or coercion preventing union membership and granting the right to city employees to bargain collectively and negotiate with public officials through union representatives on wages, working conditions and fringe benefits and providing grievance procedure of individual employee and group employees grievances.

and,

WHEREAS, objections have been filed to said ballot title.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of Oregon City that the following ballot title, to-wit:

Charter amendments amending Section 8 of Chapter II and Section 43 of Chapter VII of the Charter and amending Section 57 of Chapter VIII by adding new Sections 57B and 57C; removing the power of the City Manager to discharge any employee without cause; providing a system of civil service for all employees, excepted elected officials, manager, recorder, attorney and health officer; providing that city employees have the privilege of joining a union and may bargain collectively with all public officials and establishing a system to resolve employee grievances.

There was discussion regarding the placing of signs at the city limits prohibiting the throwing of litter on streets and stating that there was a \$100 penalty therefor.
