ORDINANCE NO. 1327

An ordinance vacating all of the alley running through Block 49, County Addition, Oregon City, Oregon

OREGON CITY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Commission of Oregon City has instituted proceedings to vacate all of the alley running through Block 49, County Addition, Oregon City, Oregon, and the consent to said vacation has been filed herein by the owners of all of the land abutting said alley in Block 49, and that notice by publication and posting of the proposed vacation of said alley has been given as by law required, and that the public interest will not be prejudiced by the vacation of said alley therefore.

Section 2. That all of the alley running through Block 49, County Addition, Oregon City, Clackamas County, Oregon, according to the duly recorded plat thereof between Division street and Lincoln Street in said Oregon City, be and the same hereby is vacated.

Read first time and ordered published at a regular meeting of the City Commission of Oregon City, Oregon, held on the 7th day of November, 1945, and to come up for second reading and final passage at the regular meeting of said City Commission to be held on the 5th day of December, 1945 at the hour of 1:00 o'clock p.m.
