## ORDINANCE NO. 1374

An ordinance redistributing the duties of the departments of the City Administration and assigning other duties to the departments and assigning the commissioners to certain departments and declaring an emergency.

## OREGON CITY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: -

Section 1. Department No. 1 shall have charge of finance, streets, planning commission and health and Mayor- Commissioner Abert Roake is hereby assigned to said department.

Section 2. Department No. 2 shall have charge of police, municipal court, law and fire and Commissioner Richard W. Long is hereby assigned to said department.

Section 3. Department No. 3 shall have charge of water, public property and recreation and C ommissioner George Helzer is hereby assigned to said department.

Section 4. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, public health and safety of Oregon City, in this: That it is necessary that the duties of the departments of the City administration be redistributed among the Commissioners and other departments added immediately, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Commission and approval by the Mayor.

Read first time and ordered published at an adjourned regular meeting of the Commission held on the 11th day of January, 1951, and to come up for second reading and final passage at a regular meeting of the Commission to be held on the 7th day of February, 1951, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M.
