Mayor Caufield brought up the request of Police Chief Alldredge to be retained for one year beyond his retirement age. It was the opinion of the Commission that inasmuch as they had made it a rule not to ask for the retainment of anyone beyond their retirement age that they would not make an exception in this case.

Mr. Mansfield appeared before the Commission and discussed the Centennial Celebration to be held in Oregon City on August 12th to 15th inclusive.

The City Manager brought up the matter of moving the Campbell home located at 429 Linn Avenue to a new location on the S.E. corner of 5th Street and East Street in exchange for Mrs. Campbell's property to provide more right of way for the County in widening Linn Avenue. The Commission felt that the cost involved was too high and the matter should be dropped for the time being.

The City Manager brought up the matter of a wire guard requested by Mr. Wallace Caufield to be built on the railing of the S.P. stairway and overhead crossing leading to Singer Hill in order to keep the pedestrians using the overhead and stairs from throwing bottles, papers, and thrash onto the roof of Mr. Wallace Caufield's property located on 7th and Railroad Avenue. The Commission decided that the furnishing and erecting of this requested safeguard was not the responsibility of the city and instructed the City Manager to inform Mr. Wallace Caufield.

The City Attorney's and City Manager's report and recommendation concerning the combining of the Treasurer's and Deputy Recorder's jobs with that of Recorder requested by the Commission at their regular meeting in July was that until the Commission felt that the time was right to ask for a Charter ammendment from the people dividing the Recorder's job from that of the Municipal Judge, the Commission should appoint Judge Stipp City Recorder and Doris Gilbertson Deputy Recorder; Judge Stipp to handle all court business, sign all warrants and necessary papers with Miss Gilbertson to handle all other duties that could be handled by a Deputy, and that there be no change in salary unless the Commission felt that the business in the court had increased sufficient to warrant an increase in the Judge's salary.

Ordinance #1353, an ordinance vacating all that part of Eighth Street, now known as Marshall Avenue, CANEMAH, according to the duly recorded plat thereof in Clackamas County, Oregon, within the corporate limits of Oregon City, Oregon, which lies between Blocks fifty-six and fifty-seven in said Canemah, was read the second time and on motion placed on its final passage, and it appearing from the certificate of Van Hoy O. Ballou, principal clerk of the Publisher of the Oregon City Enterprise, that the same had been properly published as required by the Charter, the ordinance was passed.

The following resolution was introduced and on motion adopted.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the State of Oregon, through the Adjutant General of the Oregon National Guard, has requested use of a portion of Waterboard Park in Oregon City, Clackamas County, Oregon, dsecribed as follows:

Beginning at a point which is S. 35° 30' W. 330 feet distant from the intersection of the center line of Second Street and the center line of John Adams Street in Oregon City, according to the duly recorded plat thereof in Clackamas County, Oregon, thence S. 35° 30'W. 220 feet, thence S. 3° 04' E. 110 feet to a point, thence S. 86° 56' W. 135 feet to a point, thence N. 3° 04' W. 120 feet to a point, thence N. 70° 46' E. 100 feet, thence N. 30° 23' E. 73 feet, thance N. 55° 19' E. 58 feet, thence No. 86° 10' E. 100 feet to the place of beginning except that part in roadways as now constructed and subject to the restriction that no building shall be placed closer than 10 feet from the edge of the existing roadways as now constructed,

for the erection of National Guard building units for a period of five years from the date hereof with option to renew the same for an additional five year period, and

WHEREAS it appears to the best interests of Oregon City that said request be granted,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Recorder for and on behalf of Oregon City be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a lease for five years from the date hereof with the State of Oregon, through the Adjutant General of the Oregon National Guard, for the above described property without rent, said lease to be renewable for an additional five year period and to be under the conditions as therein set forth.

LEASE

THIS LEASE, made and entered into this 6th day of August, 1948, by and between OREGON CITY, a Municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, party of the first part, hereinafter called the lessor, and THE STATE OF OREGON, party of the second part, hereinafter called the lessee,

WITNESSETH: That the lessor, for and in consideration of the covenants, agreements, and stipulations hereinafter contained, does hereby demise and lease unto the lessee the following described real property in Clackamas County, Oregon, to-wit:

Being a part of Waterboard Park, Oregon City, Oregon; beginning at a point which is S. 35° 30' W. 330 feet distant from the intersection of the center line of Second Street and the center line of John Adams Street in OREGON CITY, according to the duly recorded plat thereof in Clackamas County, Oregon, thence S. 35° W. 220 feet, thence S. 3° 04' E. 110 feet to a point, thence S. 86° 56' W. 135 feet to a point, thence N. 3° 04' W. 120 feet to a point, thence N. 70° 46 E. 100 feet, thence No. 30° 23' E. 73 feet, thence N. 55° 19' E. 58 feet, thence N. 86° 10' E. 100 feet to the place of beginning except that part in roadways as now constructed and subject to the restriction that no buildings shall be placed closer than 10 feet from the edge of the existing roadways as now constructed.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said premises, together with the appurtenances thereto appertaining, unto the said lessee from August 6, 1948, to and including August 5, 1953, for a term of five years, subject to renewal hereof as hereinafter provided.

The lessor and lessee further covenant, stipulate and agree as follows:

- l. That the lessee shall erect upon said premises a quonset hut or huts for an Armory, and maintain in connection therewith, a unit of the Oregon National Guard, or such military organization as shall succeed said Guard Unit, and during the term of this lease and renewal hereof, shall keep the improvements and grounds surrounding the same, in a reasonably good and respectable condition.
- 2. The lessee shall have possession of said premises from and after the date hereof, and shall continue in the quiet and undisturbed possession thereof as long as it shall faithfully and fully perform the covenants herein contained which are incumbent upon it to do and perform; but if at any time said Guard unit shall be disbanded without any military unit to succeed it in the use of said premises, for a period of sixty (60) days, this lease or extension hereof shall automatically terminate.
- 3. The within term may be renewed, for an additional term of five years at the option of the lessee upon giving notice in writing to the lessor not less than ten (10) days before the expiration of the within term of its intention to so renew this lease, it being understood that the maintenance of said military unit in said Armory, and the other obligations of the lessee herein expressed shall be the consideration for the renewed term hereof.
- 4. In the event the lessee shall disband said military unit, and no other military unit of the State or Rederal Government shall replace it for a period of sixty (60) days, or the lessee shall fail, refuse or neglect to comply with any of the other terms hereof, this lease may be terminated by the lessor upon ten (10) days written notice by its Recorder to the Adjutant General of the Oregon National Guard, or the officer succeeding him, if any, or if there be none, to the Secretary of State.
- 5. In the event this lease shall not be renewed or shall be terminated for any reason, the lessee shall have sixty (60) days from the expiration or termination hereof, as the case may be, within which to remove the Armory or other improvements from said premises; provided, however, that if said Armory and improvement s shall not be removed from said premises within sixty (60) days from the expiration or termination of the within term or renewal hereof, any and all improvements remaining shall become and be the property of the lessor.
- 6. The lessee shall not commit or permit any strip or waste upon said premises, and any damage thereto through the fault or negligance of the lessee shall be promptly repaired at its own expense, and the premises shall be maintained and returned to the lessor at the expiration or termination of the within term or renewal hereof, in as good condition as when the same was entered upon by it.
- 7. This lease shall not be assigned for any purpose except for the maintenance by the assignee of headquarters for a State or National military unit, and the premises shall not be used by the lessee for any other purpose. Provided that all of the terms hereof shall extend to and be binding upon any sub-lessee or assignee of the within lessee.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this lease in duplicate, the lessor by its Mayor and attested by its City Recorder pursuant to resolution of its City Commission, and the lessee by the Adjutant General of the Military Department thereof.
