ORDINANCE NO. 1206

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and City Recorder to enter into a contract with Jacobsen-Jensen Company of Portland, Oregon for the construction of a sewer in Sewer District No. 22.

OREGON CITY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and city recorder are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Jacobsen-Jensen Company of Portland, Oregon, for the construction of a sewer in Sewer District No. 22. The contract to contain a stipulation to the effect that where the cost of the improvement under the provisions of the contract, shall exceed one-half of the value of the property assessed for the cost of the improvement, that the said excess shall be paid out of the general fund of Oregon City, Oregon, and as to the balance, the contractor shall look for payment to the sum assessed upon the property liable to pay for said
