SPECIAL MEETING

The City Commission met in special session on the above date at the City Hall at 1:00 P.M.

Roll call showed the following present: O. A. Pace, C. H. Caufield and L. O. Harding, commissioners; C. Schuebel, City Attorney; J. L. Franzen, City Manager.

Upon motion the City Manager was authorized to purchase a truck from the Taylor Motor Car Co., for the sum of Six Hundred Twenty-Five (\$625.00) Dollars and one of the Cities old trucks.

Ayes: Pace, Caufield and Harding.

On motion the City Manager was authorized to have the offices in the Municipal Building reconditioned, the estimate of the amount being approximately Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars,

Ayes: Pace, Caufield and Harding.

After considering water rates to be established for water used through meters the City Attorney was instructed to draw an ordinance establishing meter rates: 600 Cu. Ft. for \$1.50 the next 2000 Cu. Ft. \$0.08 per hundred cu. ft. all over 2600 cu. ft. \$0.06 per hundred cu. ft.
