Special Meeting

The City Commission of Oregon City met in special session on the above date in the office of the City Manager at 1:00 o'clock P. M.

Roll call showed the following present: Pace, Caufield, and Harding, commissioners; J. L. Franzen, City Manager.

The following resolution approving the plans and estimates of the city engineer for the construction of the sewer in Canemah was, on motion, adopted.

Resolution and Notice

Resolution and notice to construct a sewer in Sewer District No. 22.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an order of the city commission of Oregon City made on the 5th day of June, 1929, the city Engineer of said city has submitted the report and filed with the city recorder plans and specifications and estimates for the construction of a sewer in Sewer District No. 22, the said estimates being approximately \$8,103.42, and

WHEREAS, the said sewer is appropriate and the construction expedient, the said plans and specifications are hereby adopted and approved.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that it is the intention of Oregon City, Oregon, to construct the said sewer according to the said plans and specifications. Said plans and estimates are hereby referred to and made a part of this resolution. The location of said sewer is described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 6, Block 20, thence westerly on the alley 100 feet, thence southerly at right angles to the alley in Block 2, thence westerly along the said alley in Block 2 to the westerly side of Block 2, thence along the west side of Blocks 2, 3, and 4, to the southerly side of Lot 1, Block 4, thence easterly along the southerly side of Lot 1, Block 4, 100 feet, thence easterly at right angles to the southerly side of Block A, thence easterly along the southerly side of Block A to Main Street, thence southerly on Main Street to a point 50 feet south of the southerly side of First Street, thence at right angles to a point 100 feet east of the easterly side of Main Street, thence at right angles 50 feet to a point on the northerly side of Block I, thence northerly and parallel to the east side of Main Street and 100 feet distant therefrom, to the line between lots 7 and 8, Block B, thence easterly on the line between lots 7 and 8, Block B, across Center Street and on the line between lots 1 and 2, Block C, thence northerly at right angles and parallel to the east side of Center Street 100 feet therefrom, to the southerly side of Sixth Street, thence westerly on the southerly side of Sixth Street to the line between lots 1 and 8, Block 8, thence northerly at right angles to the alley between Sixth and Seventh

Streets, in Block 19, thence westerly along said alley to place of beginning.

RESOLVED, that the following described sewer be known as Sewer District No. 22, and hereby is created:


All of lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Block 9; all of lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Block 10; all of lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Block 11; all of lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Block 12; lot 1, Block C; all of lots 3 and 4, Block 19; all of blocks 8, 7, 6, 5, and lots 1, 2, 3, 4, and 8 of Block B; all of lots 5 and 6, Block 20; all of lots 5, 6, 7, and 8 of Block 1; all of lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 of Block 2; all of Block 3; all of lots 1, 5, 6, 7, and 8 of Block 4; all of lots 5, 6, 7, and 8 of Block A; and lot 1, Block I, Canemah addition to Oregon City.

And the said described district is hereby declared to be benefited by said sewer and is to be assessed for the cost of the construction of the same.

The recorder is hereby directed to publish this resolution and notice that the property owners affected may have twenty days in which to file written remonstrance against the said sewer, as directed by the city charter.

Special Meeting

The City Commission of Oregon City met in special session on the above date in the office of the City Manager in the Municipal Building at 1:00 o'clock p.m.

Roll call showed the following present: Pace, Caufield and Harding, commissioners; J. L. Franzen, City Manager.

The improvement of Railroad Avenue from 8th street to 9th street was taken under consideration and on motion the engineer was instructed to prepare plans and estimates for the improvement of Railroad Avenue from the north side of 8th street to the south side of 9th street. Plans and estimates having already been prepared, they were signed and presented and the same was approved by the following resolution:

Resolution

A resolution for the improvement of Railroad Avenue from the north side of 8th street to the south side of 9th street in Oregon City Oregon.

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the city commission of Oregon City, Oregon heretofore made, the city engineer of said city has submitted his report and filed in the office of the city recorder plans and specifications for two kinds of improvement of the westerly portion of Railroad avenue in Oregon City, Oregon, from the north side of 8th street to the south side of 9th street, and estimates of the work to be done thereon and the cost of each class of improvement.

Therefore Be It Resolved that it is the intention of Oregon City, Oregon to improve said street with one of two kinds of improvement for which plans and specifications and estimates have been prepared by the city engineer, and which are now on file in the office of the city recorder. Said two kinds of improvement being as follows to-wit:
