ORDINANCE NO. 1433

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF LOTS 7 and 8, BLOCK 9, OREGON CITY, HERETOFORE DEEMED FOR STREET PURPOSES AND HEREIN MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED.

WHEREAS, it appears to the Commission of Oregon City, Oregon, that on the 7th day of November, 1956, a resolution was duly adopted by the Commission initiating action for the vacation of a portion of lots 7 and 8, Block 9, Oregon City, hereinafter described, and thereafter the City Recorder caused Notice to be given by posting a publication as required by law and that proof of said posting of said posting and publication is on file with the City Recorder and that the matter of said vacation, together with the hearing of any objections or claims concerning said vacation would be heard and considered at 1:00 o'clock p.m. on Tuesday, the 11th day of December, 1956, in the Commission Meeting Room in the City Hall in Oregon City, Oregon, and it appearing that no objections or claims have been filed in writing concerning said vacation and that the assessment made and determined by the Commission pursuant to Ordinance No. 1429 has been paid and that a waiver of notice of said assessment has been filed with the City Recorder, Now Therefore,

OREGON CITY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described portion of Lots 7 and 8, Block 9, Oregon City, to wit:

All that portion of Lots 7 and 1, Block 9, Oregon City according to the duly recorded plat thereof lying North of the following described line to wit: Beginning at a point in the Southwesterly line of Lot 7 which is 20 feet Southeasterly from the Southeasterly line of Water Street on the original plat of Oregon City; thence Easterly to the Southwesterly side of Moss Street at a point which is the corner of said street of Lots 8 and 1 in Block 9 aforesaid; excepting therefrom that portion of Lot 7 aforesaid which is actually paved and used for street purposes,

be and the same is hereby vacated.
