Was Read and adopted and ordered Placed on file

A resolution and notice for the improvement of the Alley in Block 4 of Oregon City Oregon from main Street to water Street was read and adopted and ordered published as required by the charter,

An Ordinance declaring the Assessment for the Improvement of Sixth Street from R.R. Avenue To Water Street was read and an affidavit showing the same had been properly published according to Law the same was placed on its final passage and the vote resulted as follows, Ayes Bridges, Cross, VanAukin. Krassig. Mount, Metzner Noes None, Absent Jack,

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and City Recorder to enter into a contract With Edmund Bergholtz to furnish Plans and Specifications and superintend the construction of the New City Hall and providing for the Payment of \$300.00 on acct , from the emergency Fund to be paid back from the Sale of the City Hall Bonds came up for second

reading and final passage an affidavit showing that same had been properly published the same was placed on its final passage and the vote resulted as follows,

Councilmen. Metzner. presented the Name of Wm.H Howell for Water Commissioner, to succeed himself as Water Commissioner for the ensuing three Years Beginning June 1st 1922, and ending June 1st 1925, there being no other names presented, Mr. Howell was declared elected by the unanimous vote of the council.

It was voted to accept the bid of Fred P Morey for the improvement of 15th Street From Harrison to Division.

It was voted that the P R & L Co be instructed to install arc light at 12th and Grant Street and also one at ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Holmes Lane & Johnson Street, so Ordered

At this time The Mayor Declared the Council to meet in adjourned session on the evening of June 12th 1922 and on said date The Mayor was in the chair and the following councilmen were present Bridges, Cross, Mount, Metzner VanAukin,

Councilmen Metzner Presented the name of R.J.Hodson to fill out the unexpired term of R.Petzold as councilmen of the First Ward, no other being mentioned and after vote of the Council the Mayor declared Mr Hodson elected. and after subscribing to the Oath. he was permitted to take his seat in the Council.

In the matter of permitting a Barber Shop in a Pool Hall was referred to the Committee on Health and Police, to report back to the Council

It was Voted that the Chief of Police be instructed to have the Stand that is used for cleaning Hats in front of the Boot Black stand and O.K. Barber Shop, removed from the Sidewalk as same is contrary to Ordinance.

It Was Voted that the Chief of the Fire Department be allowed a Three day leave of absence to attend the Firemens Convention at Marshfield Ore. and that Transportation be paid from the Fire Dept Fund,

An Ordinance was submitted by the P.R.L.Co. granting a new Franchise was read and after discussion and suggestion by the Council and Taxpayers The Mayor declared that the council would meet in adjourned session on June 13th at 7.30 O'clock P.M. so that the Committee of Business men and Tax payers could go over the Ordinance and ~~MX~~ and suggest whatever changes that may be deemed necessary.
