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An ordinance prohibiting the running of freight cars on St. railways read the first time and ordered published and to come up at a special meeting of the Council, to be held June 19, 1894 at 7-30 P.M.

An ordinance fixing the license on certain callings, trades etc. read the first time and ordered published and to come up at a special meeting of the Council for second reading and passage to be held June 19, 1894 at 7-30 P.M.

An motion of the City Engineer was submitted to notify H. E. Crow to forthwith finish the Main St. Carriageway.

Moved that the City put in its own electric light plant. Unroll call. Lost.

An motion and roll call a warrant was unanimously ordered issued for the collection of the 7th street delinquent assessments together with interest and costs.

Moved that the City accept the proposition of the Electric Co. as to lighting the City and that two arc lights be put in on Third street below the bluff. Amendment offered that one of the arc lights be put at the Liberty bridge and one at the junction of 7th street and the Molalla road. Amendment carried original motion carried.

Resolutive statement as to warrants drawn on the Main St fund and on the street fund read and ordered brought up to the City surveyor.

An motion Mr. Harris was allowed to redeem his property on payment of assessment costs and interest.

An motion a ballot was taken for water Commissioner for three years in place of T. P. Ryan. Ballot resulted in 4 votes for T. C. Charnan and 2 votes for T. P. Ryan.

The mayor declared Mr. Charnan elected water Commissioner for 3 years.
