The call for a special meeting was read and ordered filed.

#### Ordinance No. 238

Entitled an ordinance providing for the location and construction of a public Road in Oregon City, Oregon from the West side line of the O & C R R right of Way on Third Street to what is known as the bluff following the bluff as near as practicable and ascending the same in a southerly direction to the westerly end of 17<sup>th</sup> St. or southerly limits of the city having been read the second time, and it appearing from the affidavit of L. L. Porter publisher of the Oregon City Enterprise that the same had been published as required by Charter was on motion and Roll Call passed upon its final passage and second passed - Ayes Chorman, Korman, Miller, Metzner and Powell. Nays Busch and Huntley.

The foregoing resolution was adopted

Be it Resolved by the City Council of Oregon City:  
 That the Committee on Streets and Public Property be  
 instructed to make no expenditure of money under  
 the foregoing ordinance, being ordinance No. 238, until  
 the County Board of Clark and Co. County authorize  
 the commencement of work for the extension  
 of the road mentioned in said ordinance, from the  
 South end of the city.
