Minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council held May 2-1900 read and approved.

Petition asking that the Council pass an ordinance closing all places of business, except those which public necessity require to remain open, was read and on motion referred to a special committee appointed by the Mayor consisting of Councilmen Albright, Busch & Huntley with instructions to prepare a suitable ordinance.

The report of the attorneys in the Stratten case was read and on motion referred to the Committee on Finance.

The resignation of J. J. Rogers as Chief of the Fire Department

was read and on motion accepted.

The Board's Report for May 1900 was read and ordered filed.
