The monthly report of the City Manager was read and on motion ordered filed.

Ordinance No. 1159, An ordinance declaring the assessment for the improvement of Alley in Block 22 Oregon, City, Oregon, was read second time and on motion ordered placed on its final passage.

The following Resolution and Notice to improve John Adams Street from the north side of Ninth Street to the north side of Tenth Street was read and adopted.

RESOLUTION

Resolution and Notice to improve John Adams Street, from the north side of Ninth Street to the north side of Tenth Street.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an order of the City Commission heretofore made, the city engineer of said city has submitted his report and filed in the office of the City Recorder plans and specifications for two kinds of improvement of John Adams Street, from the north side of Ninth Street to the north side of Tenth Street; and estimates of the work to be done thereon and the cost of each class of improvement.

Therefore Be It Resolved that it is the intention of the City Commission of Oregon City to improve said street with one of two kinds of improvement for which plans and specifications and estimates have been prepared by the city engineer, and which are now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said city. Said two kinds of improvement being as follows, to-wit:

IMPROVEMENT NO. 1. The street shall be brought to subgrade between the curb lines of said street, from the north side of Ninth Street to the north side of Tenth Street. On the

road bed shall be placed a 2 inch asphaltic concrete wearing surface. Said street where required shall be provided with 6 ft. concrete walks and standard concrete curbs 6 x 8 x 18 inches on each side of the street.

The street shall be properly provided with drains and gutters necessary to provide proper drainage for the street.

All of said improvement shall be made according to the plans and specifications which are hereby referred to and made a part of this resolution and which were filed on the 1st day of July, 1927, in the office of the City Recorder and which plans and specifications are hereby approved.

The improvement shall be classed as asphaltic concrete and shall be maintained by the city for the full period of ten years from the date of the acceptance thereof by the City Commission.

IMPROVEMENT NO. 2. The street shall be brought to subgrade between the curb lines of said street, from the north side of Ninth Street to the north side of Tenth Street. On the road bed shall be placed 6 inches of Concrete. Said street, where required, shall be provided with 6 ft. concrete walks and standard concrete curbs 6 x 8 x 18 inches on each side of said street.

The street shall be properly provided with drains and gutters necessary to provide proper drainage for the street.


All of said improvement shall be made according to the plans and specifications which are hereby approved.

The improvement shall be classed as concrete and shall be maintained by the City for the full period of ten years from the date of the acceptance thereof by the City Commission.

The City Recorder is hereby instructed to cause this resolution to be published according to the City Charter and to give notice of publication for not less than five days in a newspaper published and of general circulation in Oregon City inviting bids for each kind of improvement provided for in this resolution.

Passed at a Regular meeting of the City Commission held on the 6th day of July, 1927.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
