The City Council of Oregon City met in regular session on the above date at the hour of 8th o'clock P.M.

The Mayor being absent President of the Council Korman presided.

Minutes of regular meeting of council held on June 7th 1899, Special meeting of council held on June 9th 1899 and adjourned meeting of council held on June 21st 1899 were read, and on motion that portion of the minutes of the regular meeting of the Council held on June 7th relating to the election of a Water Commissioner were amended to read as follows: The election of a Water Commissioner for the ensuing three years being in order, the following nominations were made, H. C. Starns and R. D. Wilson, the Mayor appointed tellers, the ballot was cast and counted with the following result: R. D. Wilson received 4 votes, and H. C. Starns received 4 votes, there being a tie, the Mayor voted for R. D. Wilson, whereupon R. D. Wilson having received a majority of all the votes was declared duly elected Water Commissioner of Oregon City, Oregon for the three years commencing July 1st 1899.

The petition of O. N. Grumman asking that he be given a license to run an express wagon for the quarter ending Sept 30th 1899 in lieu of a license paid for by him and not used for the quarter ending June 30th 1899 was read and on motion granted.

The request of Mr Harris that the men hauling rock for him be allowed to take out a license for the month of July 1899 upon the payment was upon motion granted.

The petition of A. Alice Miller et. al., offering a settlement in the matter of the Surt assessment against a part of Lots 7 & 8 of Block 29 was read and referred to the Committee on Finance.

The semi-annual report of the Water Commissioner for the half year ending June 30th 1899 was read, and on motion was ordered published and referred to the Finance Committee.

The report of the Treasurer, for the quarter ending June 30th 1899 was read and on motion referred to the Committee on Finance.

The report of the Recorder for the month ending July 5th 1899 was read and ordered filed.

The Finance Committee submitted a report stating that upon examination they found the quarterly report of the Treasurer for the quarter ending March 30/99 correct and recommended its adoption on motion the report was adopted.

Ordinance No. —

Entered an ordinance to prescribe the width of tires used on drays and wagons employed in hauling fire wood, lumber, flout or freight on the streets and highways of Oregon City was read the first time as amended and on motion the same was ordered published.

On motion the Committee on Fire & Water was authorized to purchase several Fire Extinguishers and to make any necessary repairs to the Fire Bell.

On motion the Committee on Streets & Public Property was authorized to purchase \$100.00 worth of crushed rock.

The request of the Committee on Reception to Volunteers asking that the Eddy walk be repaired and the road made passable was on motion referred to the Committee on Streets and Public Property with power to act.

On motion the Chief of Police was authorized to dispose of the old water pipe owned by the city.

On motion the Recorder was authorized to purchase a new seal for the city.

The President called Counsleman Busch to the chair.

A certificate from the Recorder of the County stating that R. D. Wilson was the owner of no real property of record within Clackamas Clackamas, was read and ordered filed.

Councilman Hornum moved that the Council proceed to

the election of a Water Commissioner to fill the vacancy caused by the expiration of the term of H. S. Stevens -

Councilman Powell moved to amend by postponing the matter until the next regular meeting of the council. The amendment was lost.

Councilmen Matyons - Schuchel & Powell asked to be excused.

No persons being present the council adjourned.
