The City Council of Oregon City, Oregon met in regular session on the above date, pursuant to adjournment at 8 o'clock P.M.

On motion Ordinance No. 252 being an Ordinance to construct a sewer system in Sewer District No. 2 of Oregon City, Oregon, was taken from the table and placed upon its final passage and declared passed, the vote being as follows:
 Ayes - Councilman Busch - Chorman - Friedrich - Grace - Huntley, Powell - Story - Nays Councilman Kornet.

The petition of Geo. E. Hargraves et al, asking that the sewer system pipes be placed in the alleys of Sewer District No 2 instead of the streets was read and ordered filed.

The Report of the Board of Water Commissioners for the 1/2 year ending June 30, 1900 was read and ordered published.

On motion the Committee on Streets and Public Property was authorized to repair the Newton Street at drain provided said repairs do not exceed the sum of \$20⁰⁰.

On motion and Roll Call the Recorder was instructed to draw a warrant on the General Fund for \$25⁰⁰ in favor of J. Steeley for \$25⁰⁰ for plans - specifications etc for work on Mine -

On motion the Recorder was instructed to notify the property owners on the northeast side of 11th Street between Madison and J. D. Adams Streets to repair the sidewalks adjoining 11th Street.

On motion and Roll call the Recorder was instructed to draw a warrant upon the General Fund for a sum sufficient to pay its taxes for the years 1898 & 1899 -
