Petition of J. A. Thayer and others asking for the improvement of 15th Street between J. Q. Adams and Madison Streets read and on motion referred to the Committee on Streets and Public Property.

Petition of E. E. Chapman and others asking the City to build a road from the south end of Main Street to Center Street at the top of the bluff read and on motion referred to the Committee on Streets and Public Property.

Petition of W. H. Burghardt and others asking that a franchise be granted to construct, maintain and operate a railway in Oregon City, read and on motion referred to the Finance Committee.

Petition of W. H. Burghardt again, asking for

a franchise to construct, maintain and operate a railway in Oregon City, read and on motion referred to the Finance Committee.

Application of J.W. Hill for renewal of license for Saloon on Main Street Between 5th & 6th Streets.

J.W. Cole for renewal of Saloon license on Main Street corner of 7th Street.

Paul Hennelgarn for renewal of license for Saloon on South Street and Railroad Ave.

and it appearing from affidavets of W.E. Bain, publisher of the Oregon City Press that all of said applicants had published as required by law a notice of their intention to apply for a license at this time and it further appearing that no remonstrance or objection to the granting of same had been filed on motion the applications of said applicants were granted and the Recordit authorized to issue said licenses.

Report of the Recordit for the month of August, showing that four trial permits and two licenses had been issued during the month and that \$273.90 being 3/5 of the cost of the Eighth street steps, as guaranteed, had been received from the following persons: C.H. & E.G. Caulfield, Bellomy & Busch, E. Mathies, Huthly Bros., A. Knapp, P.T. Morey, Hiram Straight, Red Front Trading Co., W. Yatuda and R. Prior, was read and ordered filed.

on motion and Roll Call it was placed upon its
final passage and declared passed. All Councilmen
present voting in the affirmative.

Ordinance No. 227

Entitled an ordinance creating a Road Fund,
was read for the second time, and it appearing
from the affidavit of W.E. Bain, publisher of the
Oregon City Press that the said ordinance had been
published as required by Charter, on motion
and Roll Call it was placed upon its final passage
and declared passed. All Councilmen present
voting in the affirmative.

Ordinance No 228

Entitled an ordinance instructing the
Mayor and Recorder to execute and deliver a
quit claim deed in the name of the city to
certain property in the city known as
the Ross property: read and on motion the
same was ordered published.

Committee on Fire and Water asked and were
granted further time in which to report.

On Motion the Committee on Streets and Public Property were instructed to construct a culvert on 7th and Center Streets and make all necessary improvements for taking care of the water on 7th Street at the top of the bluff.

On motion Committee on Streets and Public Property were instructed to advertise for bids for repairing and to extract for the repair of the West side of Main Street from 14th Street North across the Abenathy Bridge.

On Motion the Recordt was instructed to purchase 500 Warrants for the Road Fund.
