incurred to the defendant in the above entitled
matter. And all damages not to exceed the

by reason of the registration of the same were wrongfully

the parties named in said bonds and recover thereon

Council as provided by law and conditions
in said bond and that the recorder of said
City is hereby authorized to duly notify the
City Attorney of the action and proceedings
therein set forth
