Minutes of the regular meeting of the Council held October 5th, 1898 read and on motion that portion of the minutes relative to the removal of the 6th Street arc light was ordered stricken out, there being no other corrections the minutes as corrected were approved.

The petition of C. E. Knotts and others asking that a 32 candle power electric light be placed at the corner of 3rd & Monroe Sts. was read and on motion was referred to the Committee of Streets and Public Property.

Application of E. Matthies for renewal of Saloon License for Saloon on 8th near Main Street read, and it appearing from the affidavit of M. E. Bain published of the Oregon City Press, that the said applicant had published, as required by law, a notice of his intention to apply for a license at this time, and it further appearing that no remonstrance had been filed, on motion the application was

granted and the Records authorized to issue said license.

The report of the Records for the month of October, 1898, was read and ordered filed.

Councilman Miller of the same Committee made a verbal report recommending that the Fire Bell be not accepted, the majority report was adopted, the ayes and nays being called with the following result, those voting aye Busch, Harris, Hornum, Latourrette, Rooker and Wilson voting nay Miller.

Ordinance No -

Entitled an ordinance regulating the Oregon City Fire Department, read the second time, on motion the same was amended, read the first time as amended, and on motion was ordered published.

On motion the consideration of Ordinance No. - Entitled an ordinance authorizing M. H. Burghardt, agent to construct and maintain a railway within the limits of Oregon City, was postponed.

On motion the claim of Harry Stoper against the City for the loss of a horse was referred to the City Attorney.

On motion the Committee on Finance was instructed to take measures to protect the City's right to the land along the base of the bluff near the O. & C. Railroad Company's right of way.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to publish notice of City Election to be held Monday, December 5th 1898.
