Minutes of regular meeting of Council held Sept 6th 1899 read and approved.

Application of A. Knapp for renewal of saloon license for saloon on corner of Main and 8th Streets;

J. N. Miller for renewal of saloon license for saloon at corner of Main and 4th Streets;

J. W. Cole for renewal of saloon license for saloon at corner of Main and 7th Streets; were read and it appearing from the affidavits of W. Maud, printer and publisher of the Oregon City Enterprise, that all of said applicants had published, as required by law, a notice of their intention to apply for a license at this time, and it further appearing that no remonstrance or objection to the granting of same had been filed, on motion the application of said applicants were granted and the Recorder authorized to issue

and licenses.

The application of Rudolph Suckard, asking that he be allowed to sell liquor under license to be issued by the Recorder, provided no objection be made thereto, from the latter part of October until the regular meeting of Council in November, on motion the application was granted.

The petition of Mrs W. Loyce and others asking that a sidewalk be built on Washington St., between 13th & 14th streets was read, and on motion referred to the Committee on Streets and Public Property, with power to act.

The report of the City Treasurer for the quarter ending Sept. 31-1899 was read and on motion referred to the Finance Committee.

The Recorder's Report for the month of Sept. 1899 was read and on motion ordered filed.
