Report of the Auto Park Committee, was read , and ordered placed on fi file,

An Ordinance for the improvement of John Adams Street, Oregon City Oregon, from a point at the North side of Eleventh Street to the South side of Twelth Street and declaring an emergency, was read and on motion. it was voted to declare this to be the first reading, and order same to be published and to come up for second reading an final passage at a special meeting to be held on the 14th day of October, at &7.30 Olclock P.M. Ayes / Ibright. Bridges, Cross, VanAukin, Krassig, Mount, Petzold. Metzner. Noes, none,

U D Andrews submitted bill for the 12th street improvement. on Motion The Mayor, appointed Mr EgG Caufield. J E Jack. and John Bittner, to make appraisment of the property effected.

The City Recorder was instructed to send a bill to the Willamette Valley Southern RailRoad Co, for \$50.00 for services pendered by the Oregon City Fire Dept.

The Fire and Water Committee were instructed to draw up and submitted set of Rules, Regulating the use of the Fire appearattus.

A delegation of Jitney Drivers appered before the council and asked that permission be granted to stand in from of the following places providing AKBUN no objections were raised by the Tennants or Property owners. Which well in front of McANulty, a Barrys

W Fowler Main Street in front of Dolitles Grocery Store.

There being no objections Permission Was granted,

In The matter of the 12th street bridge, it was voted that the engineer prepare plans for same and the city Recorder be instructed to advertize for bids

In Lee asked that the Council grant him priviledge to park his cars on Ninth Street, and to leave a few minutes before time to make his schedule. It was so ordered,

G E Hayes complained about the water coming down 5th street during th rainey season, and claimed that it was doing damage to the street, and suggested that Culverts be placed so that they would protect the same He pledged himself that he would pay for one half of the labor cost if the city would give their attntion to this matter. The Matter was refered to the Street Committee.

There Being No further Business The Council Adjourned to meet in special session on the 8th day of October 1921. at 7.50.0.clock P.M?
