The City Commission of Oregon City, met in special session on the above date at the office of the City Recorder, With Mayor Andresen in the Chair, Roll call showed the following present, Andresen, Caufield, Cross,, City Attorney Schuebel, City Engøneer Stafford, Recorder Kelly
Mayor stated that the meting was called to consider certain ordinances and to take care of any other business that may come before the meeting

It was voted that Mr I D? Taylor be employed to assist the City Attorney at a salary of \$1.00 an hour, in getting out a statement of the amounts d due the City from the County Road Fund, Ayes Andresen , Caufield, Cross

It was voted that the 80% of the Contract for the Improvement of Willamette St, from Warren to Eluria street be Paid to the contractor D?D?Bain, . of the Falls Transfer Co. Ayes, Andresen, Caufield, Cross,

The Appointment of Dr. Frank Wallace. was made to act as City Health Officer for the Year 1925, and that the Salary for said officer to be Paid by the County,

Notices showing that the apportionment of the cost of the improvement of Roosevelt Street from Molalla Ave, to the Alley in Block 14 Holmes Addition and Willamette Street from Warren st, to Eluria St had been properly published and no ob jections having been filed to the said Assessments,

The following Ordinance ~~WXX~~ Was read. An Ordinance declaring the asses sment ~~WXX~~ for the improvement of Willamette Street from the west side of Warren st, to the East side of Eluria st, in Oregon City Oregon.

It was voted to consider this the first reading and that the same be ordered published and to come up for second reading and final passage at a special meeting to be held on the 21st day of January 1925 at 1.30 oclock P.M. Ayes Andresen, Caufield, Cross,

An Ordinance declaring the assessment of Roosevelt Street From Molalla Ave, to the Alley in block 14 Holesms addition to Oregon City, came up for first reading and it was voted that this be considered the first reading and that the same be published and to come up for second reading and final passage at a ~~WXX~~ special meeting to be held on the 21st day of January 1925 at 1.o'clock. P.M. Ayes Andresen , Caufield, Cross, noes. none so ordered.

An Ordinance granting to the Oregon & California Rail Road Company, its lessees, sucessors, and assigns and O.E.Meindle the right,privledge, permission, and franchise to construct and lay down, maintain, and operate an industrial spur track upon and along Center Street and across Sixteente Streer in Oregon City Oregon. came up for first reading and it was voted to consider this the first reading and that the same be ordered published and to come up for second Reading and final passage at a meeting to be held on the 21st day of January 1925 at 1,o'clock. P.M.

A Remonstrance objecting to the acceptance of Willamette Street filed January 11th 1925 was read, and as the time for filing said objecti ns, had expired, no action could be taken on the remonstrance,

An Application for the installation of a Gas Tank by the Park-Sheph erd Co, in front of their place of business on fifth, was read and onmotion permission was granted,

A petition objecting to the Spending \$2500.00 to the retention of the Eight Street Steps was read and ordered placed on file.
