The application of George Randall asking for the change of a certain Water way on Fifth and Jefferson Street and asking the City to pay a portion of the expense, was on motion referred to the Committee on Spots and Public Property, to investigate and report at the next meeting of the Council.

On motion the Committee on Health and Police and the Chief of Police was instructed to ascertain by careful investigation, all who were not connected on the ponds in Districts No. 1 & 2 and report the same to the Council in writing at the next meeting.

On motion the Treasurer was instructed to turn all moneys now in the ~~Sanitary~~ Fund into the General Fund, save and except the sum of \$50.00.

On motion the report of the Committee heretofore appointed on revision of the Charter, be adopted and that the City Attorney be instructed to prepare the necessary bill to present to the Legislature, the same to contain a provision that the 3 mill street improvement tax, shall not be operative unless adopted by the legal voters at the next regular city election.
