The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to attend the Funeral in a body and to pay our last respect to our Brother Councilman and esteemed citizen F. E . Albright,

On Motion it was voted that the Mayor appoint a committee of three to draft resolutions of condolence. and to have the same spread upon the minutes of the council and a copy furnished to the press for publication and a copy sent to the family of the deceased.

City Attorney Eby, and Councilmen Bridges, and VanAukin were appointed as such Committee,

The council adjourned and in a body attended the services held in the Presbyterian Church. and the internment in the Odd Fellows Cemetery,
