On Motion the Report was Adopted Ayes Bridges, VanAukin, Krassig Metzner, Noes  $\mathtt{Mount}$ Councilmen Mount requested that his vote be made a matter of record as he did not wish to vote for the expenditure of funds beyond those provided by the budget,

An ordinance providing for the payment of \$ 7.183.20 out of the Road Fund due the Highway commission as a payment on the New Bridge, was read second time, and as there was not a majority of the councilman present the matter was laid over to the meeting to be held on Dec 8th 1922

In the matter of having the old well filed on the Kate Newton property The City Attorney informed the council that they could not compel her to fill the said well, and nothing was done regarding the matter,

It was voted that the matter of having the Logus Estate and others comply with the requirments of the Fire Ordinance be referred to the City Attorney, with power to act,

It was voted that the street committee be instructed to have the pole and arc light at the corner of seventh and Main Street be removed to some other part of the city,

It was voted that the Street Committee provide an electric heater for the Elevator.

A certificate of acceptance XXXX by the City Engineer for the completion of John Adams Street from the North side of 11th street to the South side of Twelth street was read whereupon the following resolution was unanimously adopted,

Resolved; That Friday the 15th day of December 1922 at the hour of 7,30, o, clock P.M. at the council chamber of Oregon City Oregon be and the same is hereby set as the time and place for considering the acceptance of said street, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to give notice thereof by publication in the Banner-Courier, for two weeks prior thereto, and by mailing notice, as provided by by the Charter.

The City Recorder presented to the Council the report of the viewers appoint ed to apportion and assess the cost of the following street improvements The Alley in block 4, of Oregon City Oregon, from the Westerly line of Main street to the Easterly line of Water street;

Harrison street of Oregon City Oregon from the South side of seventh street, to the south side of Division street;

Division street of Oregon City Oregon, from the Westerline XXX side of Molalla Ave, to the East side of Harrison Street;

WHEREAS, the following resolution was unanimously adopted,

RESOLVED That Friday the 15th day of December 1922 at the hour of 7,30, o, clock. P.M. at the council chamber of Oregon City, be and hereby is set as the time and place for hearing objections to said reports and proposed assessments, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to give notice thereof in the Banner-Courier and by mailing notice to the property owners as provided by the Charter.
