The City Commissioners of Oregon City Ore,
Met in special session on the above date at the council chamber in the City hall at 1,30,0,clock P.M. With Mayor Andresen in the Chair. Roll call showed the following present. Commissioners, Cross. and And Caufield, City Attorney, Schuebel, Recorder, Kelly. Chief of Police Warren.

The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the adoption of certain resolutions and to consider any other business that may come before the Commission.

RESOLUTIONS? PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE FOLLOWING STREET WERE SUBMITTED

For the improvement of Taylor Street
From the North Side of Twelfth Street. to the pavement on Seventh Street. with a six inch concrete pavement eighteen feet wide Estimate \$8767.00

For the Improvement of Twelfth Street
From the West side of Center Street to the West side of Taylor street with a six inch concrete Pavement eighteen feet wide Estimate \$15301.00

Washington Street
For the Improvement of Washington Street from the pavement on 14th and Washington Street to the North side of Fifth Street with a six inch concrete Pavement 18 feet wide. Estimated cost. \$15785.00

Fifth Street from the East side of High Street to the East side of Jackson Street with a Six inch concrete Pavement 18 feet wide Estimated cost 12690.00

Jackson Street Easterly Half.
From North side of 16th street to North side of 17th street with Standard Macadam, estimated cost \$1670.00

Eluria Street. From Willamette street to Division Street with a 24 foot Standard macadam pavement. estimated cost \$1575.00

Alleys in Blocks 4-7-14- Holmes Addition from Division Street to Roosevelt Street with standard macadam 10 feet wide estimated cost 1327.00

In the matter of contractors using city water for City contracts it was voted that no charge for water would be made.

Ordinance No. 988 Designated as the Curfew ordinance prohibiting parents from allowing their children under the age of 18 years from upon the streets of Oregon City after certain hours was read and Affidavit showing that same had been properly published according to law it was voted to consider the same the second reading and placed on its final passage. the vote resulted as follows Ayes Andresen, Cross, Caufield. Noes none, Ordinance approved by the Mayor

A resolution to change the grade in the alley in block 23 Oregon City was read and on motion was adopted and ordered Published.

A Petition for the Improvement of Roosevelt Street from Molalla Ave

and on motion was refered to the City Engineer to prepair plans
and estimate of cost of same, so ordered *Quinn*

A petition for the improvement of Ninth Street between Taylor and
Pierce Street was presented for a 22foot macadam pavement with
concrete curbs and 6 foot sidewalks. on motion the same was referd
to the City Engineer , to make plans and specifications and the
estimated cost of same,

The Ordinance regulating signs and banners over sidewalks was
laid over to the meeting of April7th being adjurnment of April7
2od 1924
