The majority report of the committee appointed by the people recommending the construction of a sewer,

The minority report of the same committee recommending that the sewer be not constructed, and a petition protesting against the construction of a sewer were read and on motion said reports and petitions were referred to the Committee on Streets and Public Property with instructions to report at the next meeting of the Council.

A communication from the Portland General Electric Company offering a reduction in the cost of City lights of about 12½ % for a 3 years contract was read. On motion the Recorder was instructed to inform the Portland General Electric Company that a 12½ per cent reduction was not satisfactory and that a reduction of at least 25 per cent was expected.

Report of Special Committee on proposed road in South end of City was read and on motion referred to the same Committee with instructions to report at next meeting of Council.

On motion the Committee on Streets and Public Property were instructed to report at next regular meeting of Council regarding bids received for furnishing lumber.
