The City Commission of Oregon City Oregon, met in special session on the above date. at 3,0, clock P.M. with Mayor Andresen in the chair with the following present, Andresen, Caufield, Cross, Recorder Kelly

The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the matter of a City Manager,

A communication from Mr L.D. Kelsey who had been previously Appointed to the position of City Manager to take effect May 1st 1925 and stating that he could not accept the position as tendered him and thanking the Commission for favor extended,

On motion the letter was ordered placed on file, and the position of City Manager be declared Vacant,

It was voted that ~~the~~ Mr J.L. Franzen of 590 East Salmon St, be the unanimous choice of the Commission to act as City Manager beginning on the first day of May 1925, ayes Andresen Caufield, Cross,

The Recorder was directed to Notify Mr, J.L? Franze, of the appointment at once,
