Ordinance No. -

Entitled an ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder to pay \$609⁰⁰ to the Portland General Electric Company for the Electric light poles, wire, and arc lamps, used in extension to Falls View, Ely, and Kansas City, and making provision as to the title in said poles, wire and lamps, was read the first time and on motion and roll call was ordered published. All unanimous voting in the affirmative.

Ordinance No. -

Entitled an ordinance establishing Sewer District No. 2 in Oregon City and providing for the time and manner of constructing and laying down certain sewers in said district at the expense of the property benefited by such sewers as provided for by section 106 of the Charter of said City was read the first time and on motion and roll call was ordered published: Ayrs Busch, Huntley, Miller, Metzner, Powell, & Schuchel; No-Korman.

Ordinance No -

Entitled an ordinance providing for an appropriation of \$500⁰⁰ out of the road fund to be expended on the Main County Road leading from Molalla to Oregon City was read the first time and on motion and roll call was ordered published. Ayes Busch, Huntley, Korman, Metzner, Powell & Schubel No. Miller.

On motion the case of *Stoper vs City* was placed in the hands of the City Attorney.

On motion the Committee on Streets and Public Property were instructed to get plans for the steps on 4th Street.
