Ordinance No -

Entitled an ordinance authorizing G. C. Fields, his heirs or assigns, to construct, maintain and operate a railway on Main Street in Oregon City, from the intersection of Main and Third Streets, to the Southern limits of the City. was read, on motion amended, the said ordinance was again read as amended and on motion was ordered published.

Mr Fields agreed to pay the cost of publication.

Councilman Miller moved that the franchise asked for in said ordinance be not granted until the city received an offer of \$10,000.00 for the same. The motion was ~~lost~~.
