

Oregon City Oregon
August 19th 1921

The City Council of Oregon City Oregon met in special session on the above date at 7,30 o'clock P.M.

With Mayor Shannon in the chair and the following councilman Present, Albright, Bridges., Cross, VanAukin, ~~XXXXXX~~ Mount, Metzner, Absent, Krassig, Petzold.

The Mayor stated the purpose of the meeting was to take action on certain ordinances and other matters that may come before the Council.

The Following ordinances came up for second reading and final passage.

An ordinance establishing the grade of Harrison Street Oregon City Oregon from a point at the south side of Sixteenth street southerly to the south side of Fifteenth Street,

An ordinance establishing the grade of Harrison street Oregon City Oregon from the south side of sixth to the south side of Division Street

An ordinance establishing the grade of Fifteenth Street Oregon City Oregon from a point at the North East corner of Fifteenth and Harrison streets easterly to the west side of Division Street

An ordinance establishing the grade of Division Street Oregon City Oregon from the West side of Molalla Avenue, to the East side of Harrison Street,

An ordinance establishing the grade of Moss street in Green Point Oregon City Oregon from the north boundary of Green Point southerly, to the north side of Front Street.

An Ordinance establishing the grade of Abernathy Street in Green Point Oregon City Oregon, from a point 300 feet west of Moss Street, easterly to the west side of the Southern Pacific rail-road right-of-way.

An Ordinance establishing the grade Front street in Green Point Oregon City Oregon, from a point 150 feet west of Moss street easterly. to the center line of the Southern Pacific railroad track.

On motion it was voted to consider the above ordinances as the second reading and the same placed on their final Passage. result of the vote was as follows.

An Ordinance appropriating the sum of \$300.00 out of the General Fund in payment of services of M D Latourette, rendered in connection with Bond issue of May 1st 1921.

Read first time at the regular meeting held on August 3rd 1921 came up for second reading and final passage, On motion by Albright it was voted to consider it the second reading, and the same be placed on its final Passage,

An Ordinance prohibiting persons who are affected with certain diseases from engaging or working in certain occupations or employments whereby such diseases may be spread, and declaring an emergency.

Was read the second time and placed on its final passage, Ayes, Albright, Bridges, Cross, VanAukin, Mount, Metzner, Noes, none, Absent, Krassig, Petzold,

A communication from the State Highway Commission to Mr E E Brodie, was submitted to the Council in regard to columns that are to be placed in the Center of Water Street, for the New bridge, The Matter was referred to the City attorney with instructions to take the matter up with the county court,

Bids for the Improvement of Twelfth Street and the alley in block 24 were submitted by the Andrews Construction Co and Heathman Construction Co same were referred to the Street Committee, for consideration,

In the matter of the sale of the city hall same was referred back to the Finance committee for further consideration, and to report to the council

The Following Resolutions were submitted read and adopted

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE FOR SEWER DISTRICT NO. 12

WHEREAS pursuant to an order of the City Council of Oregon City, Oregon, heretofore made the City Engineer of said City has made his report and filed in the office of the City Recorder, plans and specifications for an appropriate Sewer located in Oregon City, and the boundaries of said district are as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North boundary of the Donation Land Claim of Wm. Holmes and wife, said point being 371.1 feet Westerly from the intersection of 7th Street center line and Division Street center line; thence Southerly to a point on the Westerly side of Sewer District No. 5 of Oregon City, 100 feet South of the North side of Block 9 in Holmes Addition to Oregon City, according to the duly recorded map and plat thereof; thence Westerly and parallel to North side of said block 9 to the West boundary of said block 9; thence to the Northwest corner of said block 9; thence to the Southeast corner of Block No 1 said Holmes Addition; thence Westerly along the South boundary of said Block 1 a distance of 100 feet; thence at right angles 100 feet Northerly; thence at right angles 50 feet Westerly; thence at right angles 100 feet Northerly to a point in the North side of said Block 1 said Holmes Addition 150 feet West of the Northeast corner of said block 1; thence Easterly to the place of beginning.

The plans, specifications and estimates are hereby approved and the said sewer shall be constructed with vitrified terra cotta, pipe and shall have all the necessary lamp-holes, man-holes, laterals and connections.

It shall be laid and connected according to the plans and specifications adopted and approved by this resolution.

The probable whole cost of this sewer is \$3514.19.

The City Recorder is required to have this resolution and notice published as required by the charter of Oregon City.

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE FOR SEWER DISTRICT NO 13

WHEREAS pursuant to an order of the City Council of Oregon City, Oregon, heretofore made the City Engineer of said City has made his report and filed in the office of the City Recorder, plans and specifications for an appropriate sewer located in Oregon City, and the boundaries of said district are as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 6 Block 5 of Oregon City, Oregon according to the duly recorded map and plat thereof; thence Easterly to the Northwest corner of Lot 4 of Block 25 of Oregon City; thence Northerly along Easterly line of Main Street to the Northwest corner of Lot 5 said Block 25; thence Easterly on Westerly line of Lots 5 and 2 said Block 25 and on a projection of said line to the center of the main line of the Southern Pacific Railroad as now located and constructed; thence Southerly along the center line of said Railroad's main line to a point of intersection of the North line of the alley in Block 26 of Oregon City extended Easterly; thence Westerly along the North line of said alley and of the alley in Block 4 of Oregon City to the Southwest corner of Lot 7 of said Block 4; thence Northerly along the Easterly line of Water Street to the place of beginning.

The plans, specifications and estimates are hereby approved and the said sewer shall be constructed with vitrified terra cotta, pipe and shall have all the necessary lamp-holes, manholes, laterals and connections.

It shall be laid and connected according to the plans and specifications adopted and approved by this resolution.

The probable whole cost of this sewer is \$1329.70.

The City Recorder is required to have this resolution and notice published as required by the charter of Oregon City.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS pursuant to an order of the city council heretofore made the City Engineer has filed in the office of the Recorder of Oregon City a proposed change of the grade of the alley in Block 24 of Oregon City, Oregon, from the Westerly line of Railroad Avenue to the Easterly line of Main Street, and

WHEREAS, said proposed change of grade is satisfactory to the city council of Oregon City.

THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED that said proposed change of grade is hereby approved and be it further

RESOLVED that it is the purpose and intention of the city council of Oregon City, Oregon, to change the grade of said Alley in Block 24 of Oregon City, Oregon, from the Westerly line of Railroad Avenue to the Easterly line of Main Street in accordance with said proposed change as submitted by the city engineer, so that the same shall be as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the East side of Main Street at an elevation of 106.8 feet; thence Easterly 140 feet to an elevation of 110.5 feet; thence to the West side of Railroad Avenue to an elevation of 110.8 feet.

The city recorder of Oregon City is hereby directed to have this resolution published as by the charter provided.

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE

Resolution and notice, for the improvement of Division Street, Oregon City, Oregon, from the West side of Molalla Avenue, to the East side of Harrison Street.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an order of the City Council of Oregon City, Clackamas County, Oregon, heretofore made, the City Engineer of said City has submitted his report and filed in the office of the City Recorder, plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of Division Street, Oregon City, Oregon, from the West side of Molalla Avenue, to the East side of Harrison Street, and estimates of the work to be done thereon and the cost thereof, and

WHEREAS, such plans, specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the City Council of Oregon City, Oregon.

WHEREFORE the said plans, specifications and estimates are hereby approved and adopted, and be it

RESOLVED: That it is the intention of the City Council of Oregon City, Oregon, to make the said improvements, being described as follows, to-wit:

The Street shall be brought to subgrade which shall be prepared according to the specifications referred to; on the subgrade shall be laid a four course macadam as shown in said specifications, six inches at curb, nine inches at center and 18 feet wide, with four foot concrete walks on each side. When the street is completed it shall be at the established grade.

The City Recorder is hereby directed to cause this resolution and notice to be published as required by the charter.

The City council of Oregon City Oregon met in special session on the above date at 5,15 o'clock P.M. with President of the council I C Bridges Acting Mayor in the Chair and the following councilmen present. Albright. Bridges, Krassig. Mount. Metzner VanAukin. Absent, Cross. Petzold.

The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was called to consider the report of the Finance committee regarding the sale or lease of the present city hall.

The committee reported that Ruconich and Ropell offered to lease the building for a period of ten years at an annual rental of 1800.00 dollars a year, providing suitable arrangement can be made with Mr Busch and the city.

On motion by Metzner. it was voted that the Finance committee be instructed to meet with the parties interested and the City Attorney and have a lease drawn up and submit the same to the council for their approval at a special meeting of the council to be held on Monday Evening August 29th 1921 at 7,30, o'clock.P.M.

In the latter of the improvement of the alley in Block 24 and 12th Street between Center and Main. the Bids for same were read and rejected. And a motion prevailed to add the cost of the Cement to the Andrews Construction Co, Bid and that the City Attorney Draw a contract covering the entire cost

It was Voted that the Recorder place an order at once for the New Arc Light to be installed on Willamette Street

There being no further business the council Adjourned, to meet in special session August 29 1921 at 7,30, O'clock P.M.
