July 15th 1922

The City Council of Oregon City Oregon met in special session on the above date at the council chamber at 7:30 P.M. With Mayor Shannon in the chair. Roll call showed the following Present. Bridges, Cross, VanAukin, Hodgson. Metzner. Mount. Absent, Jack, Krassig.

The Mayor Stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider certain ordinances and any other business that may come before the council.

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 881 of Oregon City Oregon Prohibiting persons who are afflicted with certain diseases from working or engaging in certain occupations or employment where by such diseases may be spread, and providing a penalty, was read first time and on motion was ordered published and to come up for second reading and final passage at a meeting to be held on August 2nd, 1922 at 7:30 O'clock P.M.

An Ordinance for the improvement of the Alley in Block 4 of Oregon City Oregon from the westerly line of Main Street to the Easterly line of Water Street was read for the first time and on Motion was ordered published and to come up for second reading and final passage at a meeting to be held on August 2nd, 1922 at 7:30, P.M.

Ayes Bridges, Cross, VanAukin, Hodgson, Mount, Metzner, Noes, none Absent, Jack Krassig.

An Ordinance, Establishing Sewer District No. 14, and providing that property owners therein shall make connections with the public sewer thereof, was read first time and on motion was ordered published and to come up for second reading and final passage at a meeting to be held on August 2nd, 1922 at 7:30, P.M. Ayes, Bridges, Cross, Hodgson Van Aukin, Mount, Metzner. Noes none Absent Jack, Krassig.

An ordinance for the improvement of John Adams Street Oregon City Oregon, from the North line of Seventh Street to the South line of Ninth Street, was read for the first time and on motion was ordered published and to come up for second reading and final passage at a meeting to be held August 2nd, 1922, at 7:30, P.M.

Ayes, Bridges, Cross, VanAukin, Hodgson, Mount, Metzner, Noes none absent, Jack, Krassig.

A Petition from the Property owners of the property adjacent to the alley in Block 127 asking that the said alley be vacated was read and ordered published.

The Applications of Leland & Little, Chas, Busch, Wheeler & Co. and A E T Timms for the Renewal of their Pool Hall Licences affidavits showing that same had been properly advertized and on motion the said licenses were Granted

It was voted that the City Recorder be instructed to advertize for bids for \$9322.43 worth of Improvement Bonds, to cover liens against the improvements of 12th Street, Sixth Street, Eighth Street, and Alley in Block 24 said bids to be opened August 2nd at 2:30, o'clock P.M. 1922

It was voted that the City Recorder advertize for bid for the paving of 2600 feet of concrete pavement for Molalla Avenue, Pavement to be 18 ft wide and six inches thick.

The Matter of removing old cross walks at 8th and Monroe and 4th and Monroe was referred to the street committee.

Unit Bids for the City hall were submitted and the Mayor declared that the council would sit as a committee of the whole to consider same, after consideration the council on motion rejected all bids and concluded to take further time regarding the matter.

A letter from the Highway Commission was read regarding the routing of the Highway, and on motion the City Attorney was instructed to ask the Highway Commission to arrange a meeting with the council at as early a date as possible.

A Petition from the Grocery Men's Association asking that Wednesday July the 26 be declared a Holiday was presented and on motion the Mayor granted their request and declared said day a Holiday,

The Mayor Requested that the Council and all citizens meet at the council chamber Thursday July 27 at 7,30 O'clock P.M to discuss the routing of the Highway, and the matter of the vacation of certain streets, and to notify Mr Caulfield of said meeting. X

It was voted that the Fire & Water Committee Purchase 500 ft of new hose for the Fire Dept. so ordered,

The Recorder was instructed to notify the Otis Elevator Co to make an examination of the Elevator at once

The Mayor instructed the council that the Highway commission would meet in Portland on Tuesday July the 25 and asked that all councilmen should be present at said meeting as matters of importance would be discussed. X
