It was woted that the City Recorder advertize for bid for the paving of 2600.feet of concrete pavement for Molalla Avenue, Pavement to be 18 ft wide and six inches thick,

The Mater of removing old cross walks at '8th and Monroe and 4th and Monroe was refered to the street committee.

Unit Bids for the City hall were submitted and the Mayor declared that the council would sit as a committee of the whole to consider same, after consideration the council on motion rejected all bids and concluded to take further time regarding the matter.

A letter from the Highway Commission was read regarding the routing of the Highway, and on motion the City Attorney was instructed to ask the Highway Commission to arrange a MARKENDENTAL meeting with the council at as early a date as possable.
