

It was voted that the Oregon City Sand and Gravel Co be paid a warrant for 75% of the amount due for the improvement of 15th to 16th street, so ordered,

In the matter of improvements Bonds the same was referred to the Finance Committee,

Metzner suggested that the \$5,000.00 as provided by the budget for permanent Roads be expended on Linn avenue, it was voted to lay the matter over to the special meeting to be held July 18th 1923

~~XXX~~ Councilmen Cameron moved that the Chief of the Fire Department be allowed his actual expense to the Fireman's Association to be held at Bend Oregon, motion carried and so ordered,

The Engineer stated that he thought that he could use the rock that would come off of 5th street at an advantage to the city,

Beatie, moved that the Engineer be permitted use his own judgement in the matter and to act accordingly, so ordered,

The Mayor stated that he would procure a plan from the State Engineer for a bridge at 17th and Washington Street.

Beatie moved that an ordinance providing for getting out a complete statement of the liabilities and assets of the City, so ordered, ✓

There being no further business the council adjourned to meet in special session July 18th 1923 at 7.30, o'clock P.M.

The City Council of Oregon City Met in special session on the above date at the council chamber at 7.30, o'clock P.M. With Mayor Shannon in the Chair. Roll call showed the following present,

Roake, Cameron, Greaves, VanAukin, Metzner, Beatie, Absent Krassig, Mount, The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the final passage of certain ordinance and to consider any other business that may come before the council.

An ordinance establishing the grade of the alley in block 145 was read second time, and at the request of O.D. Eby it was voted to postpone action on same to the regular meeting to be held August 1st 1923, so ordered,

An ordinance for the laying and construction of sewers in Dist #15 was read second time and affidavit showing that same had been published according to law, it was placed on its final passage and the vote resulted as follows Ayes Roake, Cameron, Greaves, VanAukin, Metzner, Beatie, Noes none, absent, Krassig, Mount, Ordinance was approved by the Mayor,

An ordinance for the construction of a sewer from the present sewer at Roosevelt Street a distance of 500 feet along the Easterly side of Molalla Avenue and establishing Sewer District # 16 was Read first time and ordered published and to come up for second reading and final passage at the regular meeting to be held August 2nd 1923 at 7.30, o'clock P.M. Ayes Roake, Cameron, Greaves, Vanaukin, Metzner, Beatie, noes none, Absent Krassig, Mount,

A petition from the property owners protesting against the assessment of the cost of 15th street was presented, and read, and the Mayor stated that at the regular meeting of the Council to be held on August 1st 1923 at 7,30 o'clock would be the day set for the Council to hear complaints against the improvement and assessment,

An ordinance for the Improvement of Center Street from the south side of 9th street to the south side of 7th ~~WAS KEPT FROM THE COUNCIL~~ with a asphaltic top was read. and on motion the same was postponed indefinitely.

It was ~~voted~~ ^{and from} that the Chief of the Fire Department be allowed his railroad fare to the Fire Chiefs Convention to be held at Bend Oregon

A resolution for the Improvement of Center Street from the South side of 7th street to the south side of 9th with a concrete pavement was read and adopted and ordered published,

~~An ordinance~~ It was Voted that a vote of thanks be given to W.B. Caufield for the kindness and courtesies extended to the Finance Committee on their trip to Hood River,

On motion by Cameron it was voted that the City Recorder be instructed to advertise for bids for the construction of 1000 feet of concrete pavement 18 ft wide and six inches thick to be laid on Linn Avenue same to cost not more than \$5000.00, so ordered,

Bid for the improvement of 5th Street from R.R. Avenue to Water Street was opened and were as follows, Bid of Harry Burdine, \$8898.70 The Bid of the Oregon Contract Co was \$8763.55 The Oregon Contract Co, Bid being the lowest the contract was awarded to them. and the City Attorney was directed to prepare an ordinance authorizing the Mayor and City Recorder to sign contract for same, Ayes, Roake, Cameron, Greaves, VanAukin, Metzner, Beatie, Noes none. absent, Krassig Mount,

Bid for the improvement of Logus Street for the sum of \$2536.80 for a macadam street was submitted by Harry Burdine, and on motion was referred to the Street Committee and City Engineer, check over and report on

The City Recorder was instructed to notify the West Linn Council that a leak in their Pipe Line at 6th and Harrison Street was leaking and in a condition that was doing damage to the street and request that they give the matter their immediate attention,

The Finance Committee submitted the following Report,

To the Hon Mayor and City Council

Gentlemen: We your Finance Committee beg leave to report; as follows regarding the auditing and installation of the City's Books. We have examined the books of the city of Hood River. installed some years ago and find them systematized thoroughly, all records are complete and in such a shape that any item can be accurately traced and without waste of time, Mr Geo. W. Johnson very kindly accompanied us and from his experience with books and tax records was able at a glance to see the merits of the system and rendered us considerable assistance. Therefore we recommend an immediate audit, and installation of a system similar to Hood River, and ask that the council authorize the Mayor and Recorder to enter into a contract for an audit and installation of some adequate system for Oregon City,
