

Oregon City, Oregon, November 14-1906

The Council of Oregon City, Oregon, met in Special Session Pursuant to the call of the Mayor on the above date at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

The Mayor announced that the meeting was called for the purpose of taking action on an ordinance appropriating money for the completion of the South End Road and to consider such other matters as might properly come before the Council.

Upon motion the consideration of the ordinance appropriating money for the completion of the South End Road was postponed until an adjourned session of this meeting to be held Monday November 21-1906 at 7³⁰ o'clock P.M.

A petition asking for an arc light at the corner of 10th and Main Streets was read and upon motion referred to the Committee on Sts. & Public Property to report

at the next meeting of the Council.

The Finance Committee reported that pursuant to the instruction of the Council, bids for the sale of \$790⁷³ of Street Improvement Bonds had been advertised and that the bid of Charles H. Campfield offering the sum of \$800⁰⁰ and accrued interest for said Bonds, and recommending that said bonds be awarded to said Charles H. Campfield at the sum bid, upon motion the report was adopted.

Ordinance No. 3.4

An ordinance authorizing the issuance of improvement bonds in pursuance of the Act of the Legislature of the State of Oregon, known as the Bonding Act, as the same has been amended was read the second time and it appearing from the affidavit of J. W. Lockman that said Ordinance had been published as required by law and that notice that said ordinance was to come up for second reading and final action at this time, upon motion said ordinance was placed upon final ^(passage) ~~reading~~ and upon roll call passed, the vote being as follows: Ayes (Messrs. Chapman, Justice, Kerner, Kelly, Kuepp, Mason, Story, Shuckman and Straight (9); Nays None absent None. The Mayor announced that the ordinance had passed.

An ordinance fixing the amount of the Tax levy for general municipal purposes for the year 1904, and ~~making~~ ^(amending)
