The City Council of Oregon City Oregon Met in Special session on the above date in the council chamber at the hour of 4.0, clock P.M.

Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the recinding of a protest filed with the War Department and State Highway Commission.

The Following Resolution was submitted and adopted unanimously.

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 7th day of December 1921, a resolution was unanimously passed protesting to the war department against the present plan of structure of the bridge now being constructed across the Willamette River between West Linn and Oregon City, and

WHEREAS said time the council has made further investigation of such matter and is now fully advised in the premises and believes that under all the circumstances that such protest should be withdrawn and that said bridge should be permitted to be constructed without any objection or delay.

NOW, WHEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the City Council of Oregon City, Oregon in special session held this 21st day of December 1921, at 4:00 o'clock P.M., that the said resolution passed by said city council on the 7th day of December 1921, protesting against said plan of structure of said bridge be and the same hereby is with-drawn, and that all objections against the plan of the structure of said bridge be and hereby are with-drawn from the war department, and that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Engineer of the War Department and to the State Highway Department of Oregon.
